



REQUIRED DRIVER EXPERIENCE POLICY

HONDA CUP | RACE SERIES

Preamble

Honda Cup Articles state, in part:

6.1 Entry to the Series is by invitation and shall be made on the Honda Cup Series Registration/Entry form and submitted to the Series Secretary for acceptance together with the prescribed fee.

The New Zealand Honda Racing Drivers Club Incorporated (HRDCNZ) wishes it to be known that considerations about safety are the over-arching factors in deciding whether applicants for Series entry will be invited to join the Series.

Any experienced driver that otherwise meets our entry criteria may apply to be invited to Series entry. With respect to experience, this is largely age-dependent.

As a general rule, applications will not be considered from applicants who are less than 14 years of age. Note: Previous karting experience might reduce this requirement, at the discretion of the Committee.

All applicants must have a valid competition licence issued by MotorSport New Zealand.

The following Policy is intended as a guideline for the Committee when considering applications:

Policy

1. Driver aged 20 years or over:
 - a. Minimum of 12 months valid civil driver licence, (if aged over 20 years with civil driver licence valid for less than 12 months refer to 2, below), *and*
 - b. Participated in a minimum of three track days to practice race lines
2. Driver aged under 20 years with or without a civil driver licence, or any other driver with a civil licence valid for less than 12 months:
 - a. Completed a competition driving education course, such as Mike Eady (TrackTime) or Daniel Gaunt (Downforce), *and*
 - b. Participated in a minimum of three track days to practice race lines
 - c. Evidence of racing experience in another series may be acceptable to offset the need for 2(a) or 2(b) above, at the discretion of the HRDCNZ Committee.
3. HRDCNZ will require documentary evidence of any track day attendance and/or competition driver training referred to above.
